Program: Get to Know Your Kiwanian Series, “Molecular Vision – How grasping the details informs my outcomes” - Shahayra Majumder



Recent new member Shahayra Majumder shared how her interest in Kiwanis came about, how it has affected her life, and her current endeavour as the owner of a Hydrate IV Bar.

Shahayra’s parents immigrated to West Palm Beach, Florida from Bangladesh. Education was important to her parents. Her father was a doctor in Bangladesh, but was unable to practice in the U.S. They were not familiar with the American system of post-secondary education and did not have the funds to pay for college. Her mother’s employer was in the West Palm Beach Kiwanis and urged her to apply for scholarships for Shahayra’s older sister. Her first Kiwanis experience was attending the scholarship awards banquets for her sister. She also received Kiwanis scholarships when she finished high school.

Shahayra’s initial academic interest was genetic engineering. She researched peptides crossing the brain barrier interface and studied secondary RNA structures like the mRNA used for the Covid-19 vaccines.

Shahayra came to Madison as an Epic employee in 2019, just before the Covid pandemic. She held several other positions

before deciding to be her own boss. She met her partner in 2022, bought a condo in 2025, and opened the Hydrate IV Bar in 2026.

Her academic research into the cellular framework led to her business choice. They try to help the body do what it is designed to do by providing the right environment and ingredients to promote cellular healing and growth.

Ingredients include the well-known vitamins, minerals, and amino acids as well as enzymes, mitochondria, coenzymes, hormones, neurotransmitters, cytokines, and peptides. Studies show that the IV route is most effective at delivering these ingredients.
